## OUR MISSION

Our mission is to glorify and honor God by caring for orphans and the neediest of His children in Africa (with a focus on rural Uganda) by providing family-based care, education and a local church family.

The cycle of poverty is an all too common reality for the orphans of Africa. Finding the key to executing quality orphan care that changes the trajectory of a child's life is vital.

## LOCKED IN HOPELESSNESS

- An estimated 2.5 million orphans are currently living in Uganda.
- Orphanages are often unable to equip children for life on their own after "aging out."
- Children's villages are often institutionalized and isolated from the broader community.
- Without a church family and the security of a loving home, children suffer mentally, emotionally, and spiritually.

**KING'S KIDS AFRICA** is creating opportunities for orphans by coming alongside the local church to care for orphans and restore their dignity.

# OUR SUSTAINABLE APPROACH

## Collaborative Church Partners

- Identify local churches in Uganda who have demonstrated a love for children and are doing all they can to care for orphans, but they need a helping hand.
- Provide the start-up resources and life care support for the orphan homes, while the local church retains full ownership and is responsible to achieve long-term sustainability.
- Position the local church to be viewed by the community as the care provider.

## Collaboration is Key

Our partners have been carefully chosen for their long-term records of impact and credibility:

- Rocky Mountain Bible Church has planted 6 churches and sponsors more than 50 orphans.
- The Presbytery of East Africa has planted more than 110 churches.
- GO Africa has built more than 200 orphan homes worldwide and serves 2,300 orphans.
- eMi has worked on over 1,000 relief and development projects in more than 90 countries and has donated over 63,000 hours of service.

## Leverage Funds and Partnerships to Build Kingdom Infrastructure:

- **Homes** that will house orphans and the house moms (mostly widows) who will provide family-based care for the children, creating a new loving family.
- **Schools** that will educate the orphans and the broader community, affecting long-term change and lifting children out of poverty.
- **Churches** that will spiritually and emotionally support the orphans and widows of the homes and transform the community for the kingdom of God.



## OUR 2016 VISION

Collaborate with local churches to build **4 orphan homes** within identified strategic villages in rural Uganda.

**By 2020**, our goal is to launch **10** family-based homes, **5** schools (primary, secondary, and trade), and **3** churches.



### Bring Kingdom Infrastructure to Rural Uganda

Build an orphan home to support 8 children and one house mother:  
**\$30,000**

Support 8 children with living expenses and education for one year:  
**\$5,000**

Build a school to give the gift of education to an entire community:  
**\$450,000**

Build a church and impact a community with the Kingdom of God:  
**\$80,000**
